## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEARNING:**

Learners review unknown cases across radiography, CT, and MRI, apply a systematic approach to interpretation, and commit to a diagnosis before reviewing detailed explanations and annotated teaching materials. Content includes interactive image review, case-based learning, and focused educational summaries. Additional resources include annotated images and key learning points to reinforce interpretation skills. To claim credit, learners must complete the cases, engage with the educational content, and complete a post-activity evaluation. Overall, learners will develop stronger diagnostic reasoning, pattern recognition, and confidence in interpreting real-world images.

## **STATEMENT OF NEED:**

Radiology education has traditionally relied on passive learning methods, even though imaging interpretation is a practical skill that requires active engagement and repeated case exposure. Many radiologists lack subspecialty training across all domains and may have limited exposure to complex or high-stakes cases after residency. This leads to gaps in diagnostic confidence, systematic interpretation, and application of knowledge in clinical practice. Evidence supports case-based and simulation-based learning as more effective for improving retention and clinical reasoning. This activity addresses these needs by providing curated, high-yield cases in an immersive, PACS-like environment that emphasizes active learning, structured interpretation, and practical clinical application.

1. Apply a systematic approach to the interpretation of radiography, CT, and MRI studies.
2. Recognize key imaging patterns associated with common and high-stakes diagnoses.
